What is a Baby Safe Haven?

Sadly, babies have been abandoned next to dumpsters, in trash bags, or outside of buildings. Parents often hope that the baby will be found and cared for, but these situations too often end tragically.

To help prevent such tragedies, Safe Haven laws were created. These laws allow parents or guardians to surrender a newborn to someone at a specific location, called a Baby Safe Haven.

They can surrender their baby to someone there with no questions asked — their baby is safe, and they are legally protected from child endangerment charges. But many people still don't know about Safe Haven laws, and continue to abandon babies unsafely and illegally.







MAY 18 BLOOD DRIVE RESULTS


Thank you to all that stepped up to donate blood on May 8th! The drive was a great success! There were 3 first time donors, and we collected a total of 64 units of blood.

Pelican in Her Piety

Legend holds that a pelican, in time of great famine, would pierce its flesh to feed its babies with its own blood. The pelican has become a symbol for Christ who suffered and died to save us from our sins.

The "Pelican in Her Piety" is often featured in Eucharistic art, for example on a priest's chasuble or an altar. This symbol can help us connect Jesus' sacrificial love to the gift of the Eucharist.

St. Thomas Aquinas included this line in a hymn that he wrote: "Lord Jesus, Good Pelican, clean me, the unclean, with your Blood, one drop of which can heal the entire world of all its sins."


